



### Getting the best from Pansies – Growing Tips

Spreading Pansies are highly floriferous (bearing many flowers) and ideal for use as a ground cover or for display in hanging baskets or containers. Remove spent flowers to promote fresh blooms. Plant 45cm apart for dense coverage in a garden bed.

- Remove spent flowers to promote fresh blooms.
- Position: Full sun to part shade
- Height / Spacing: 15-20cm, 60cm apart
- Lifespan: Annual
- Planting Time: Autumn, Winter, Spring
- Flowering Time: Autumn to late Spring
- Weeks to Flower: 6-8 weeks after planting as seedlings.
- Use: Use as a ground cover in garden beds to create a superb massed display or border. Allow to spill over the edges of hanging baskets, containers or retaining walls.

They bloom for so many months so have to be one of the best flowering bargains around.
